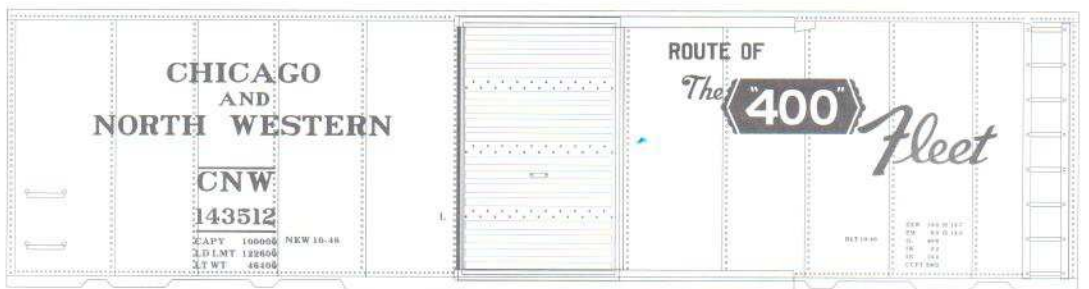
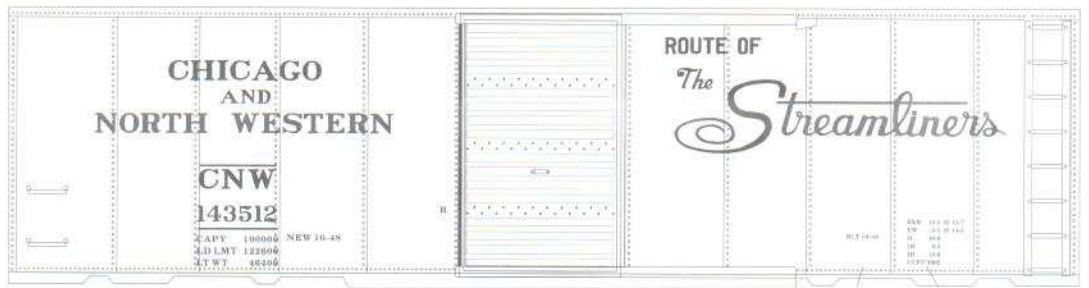
CHICAGO AND NORTH WESTERN 40' SLOGAN BOX CARS

BEING THE MOST COMMON.

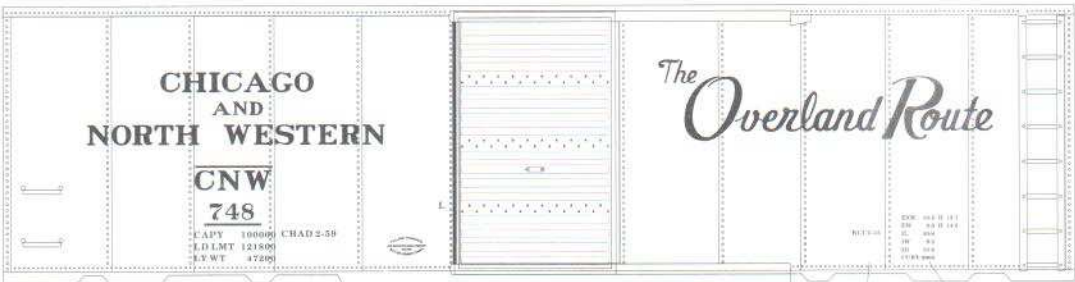
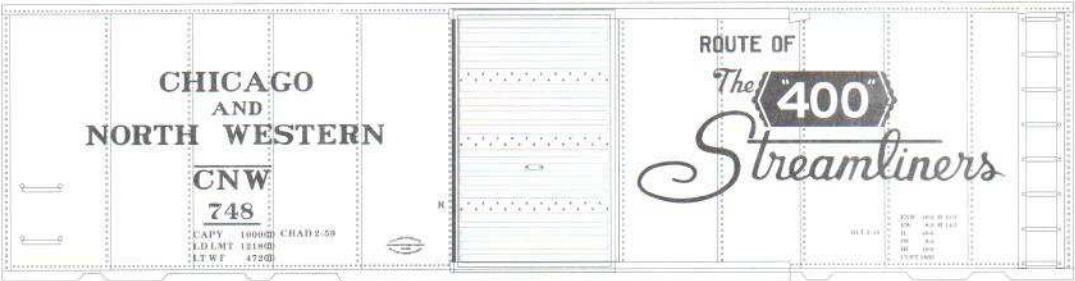


FROM 1942 TO 1956 CARS HAD DUAL SLOGANS.
THE OVERLAND ROUTE SLOGAN WAS THE MOST
COMMON SLOGAN USED ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE
CAR. ROUTE OF THE STREAMLINERS OR ONE OF THE
400 SLOGANS WERE USED ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE CAR.
THERE ARE EXCEPTIONS AND DIFFERENT VERSIONS
TO THESE CARS.

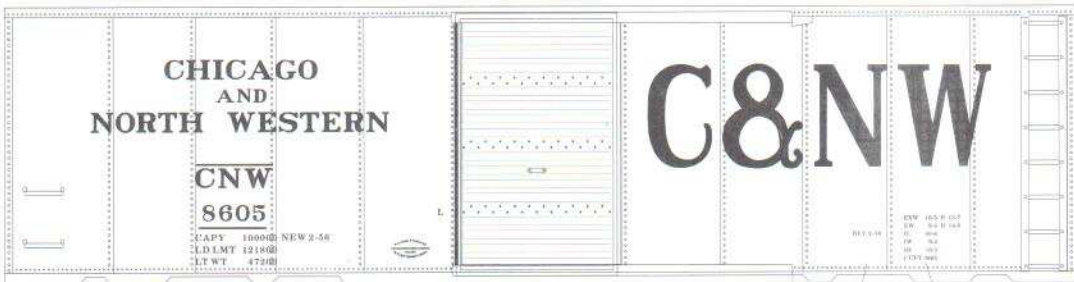


ALL CARS
