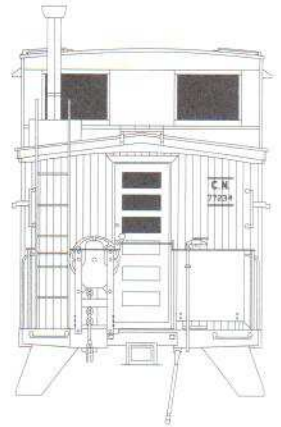
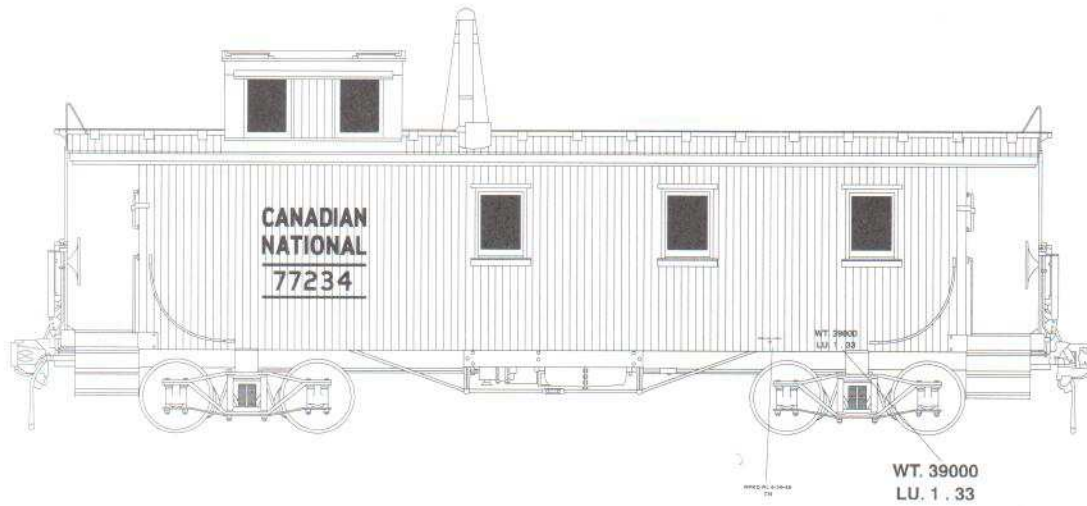

CANADIAN NATIONAL WOOD CABOOSSES

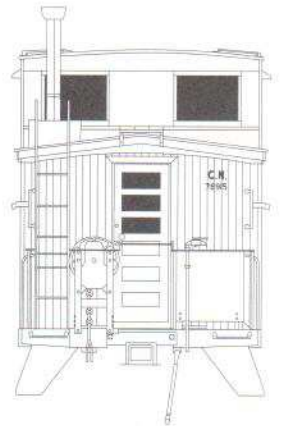
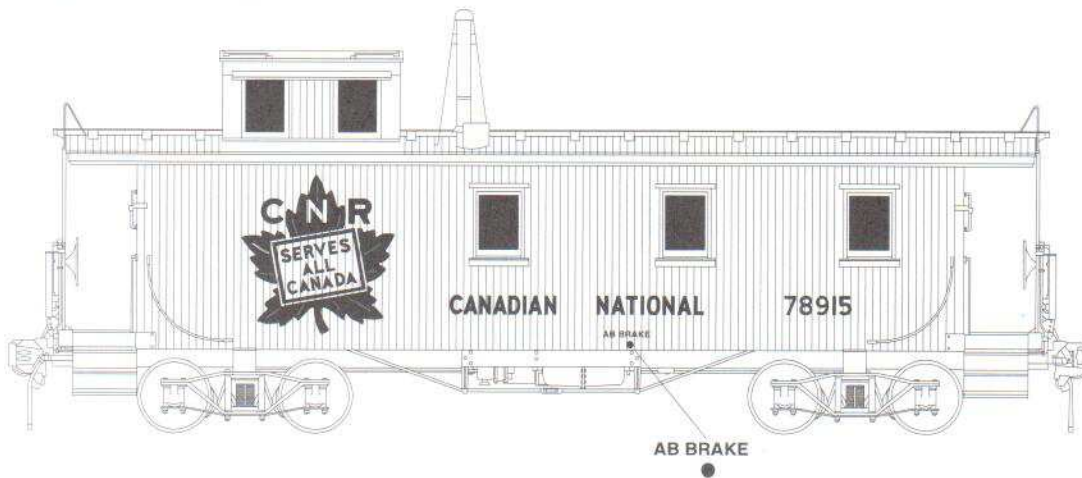
1920s TO LATE 1943

WHITE DIAGONAL MAPLE LEAF MONOGRAM.



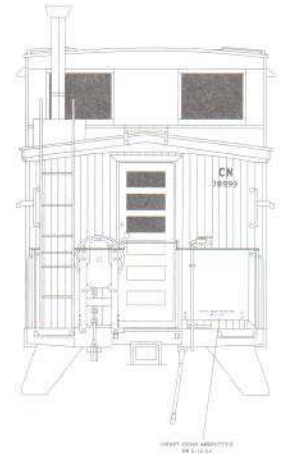
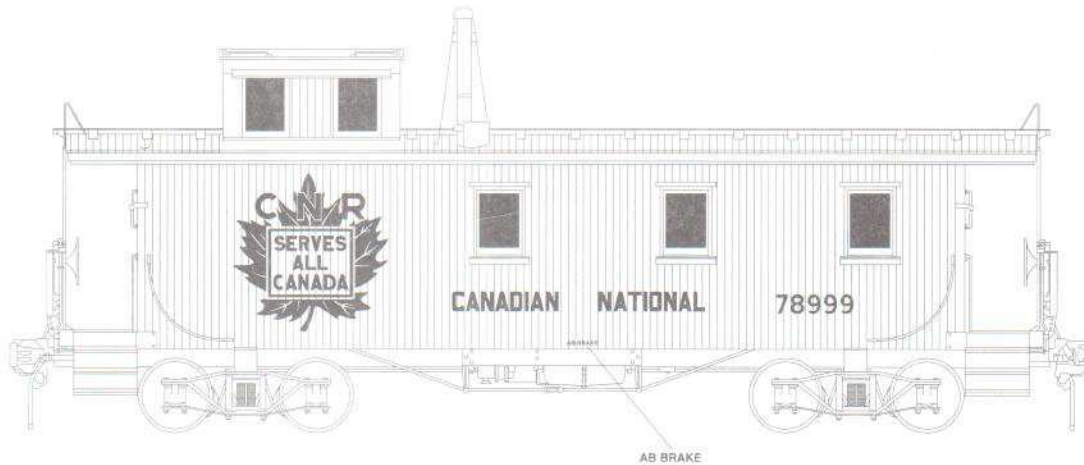

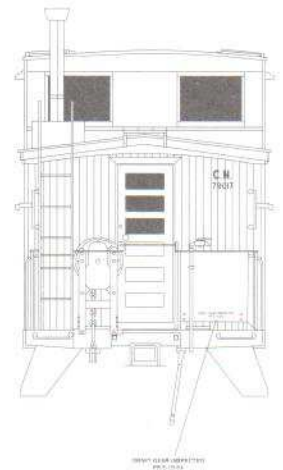
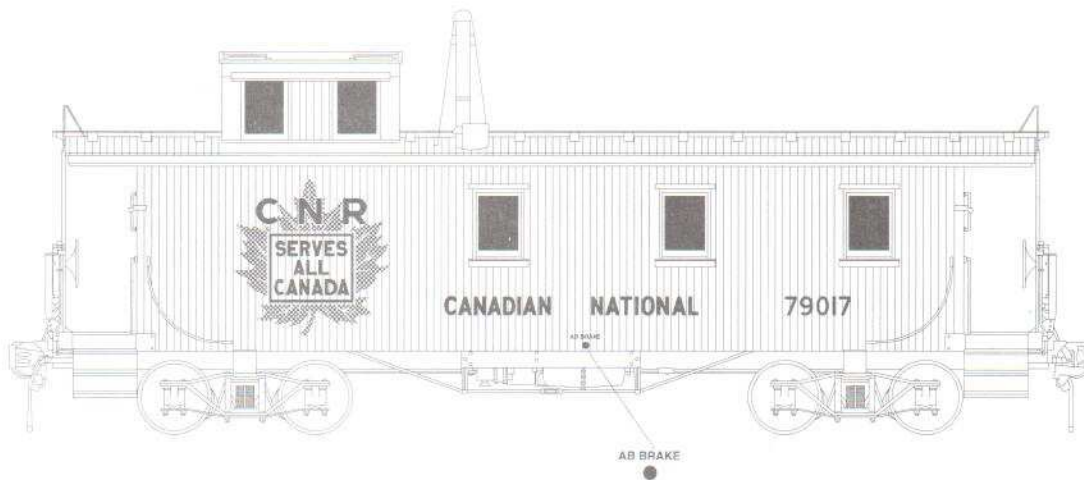
MID 1954 - LATE 1955
