

The following diesels had YELLOW ends on the *long* hood: 3601, 4549, 4550, 4551, 4923, 4928
The following GP9s had YELLOW ends on the *short* hood: 4926, 4559
Note that the YELLOW end is the *front* end. All other GP9s had GREEN on both ends (usually the long hood is to the front)

Note: Central Vermont 4926 differs from the above drawing in that it does not have dynamic brakes and has roof-mounted air tanks.

Green

(Accupaint AP-58): Entire body (as indicated in diagrams), handrails, walkways (anti-skid Black on some units), step wells.

Yellow

(Accupaint AP-23): Portions of body (as indicated in diagrams), vertical portions of handrails from steps to first stanchion, grabirons, frame stripe on sides and ends.

## Variations:

On some units, the "F" and "R" designations were changed to "F" and "B." Some of the Green snowplows have a Yellow "V" (similar to that applied in Grey on some CN units). Grabiron colors vary from unit to unit.

(Accupaint AP-58): Entire body (as indicated in diagrams), handrails, walkways (anti-skid Black on some units), step wells.

Yellow

(Accupaint AP-23): Portions of body (as indicated in diagrams), vertical portions of handrails from steps to first stanchion, grabirons, frame stripe on sides and ends.

Some engines, most notably the MLW/ALCos, have White numbers on Black number boards. RS-11 3605 has White numbers on Black number boards, as do most of the GMD/EMD engines.
