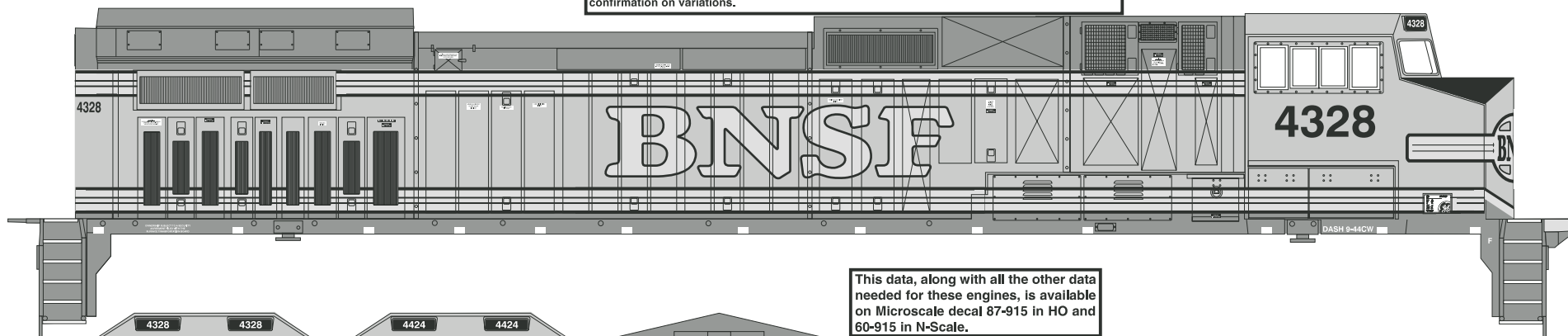

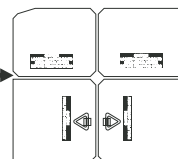
BNSF changed the size of the lettering on the nose logo during the time the 4900-series Dash 9-44CWs were being delivered, although a few earlier units ended up with this logo as well. For engines with the earlier, small-lettered logo use Microscale set 87-1024 (60-1024 in N). The following units are known to carry the logo featured on this set: 580 (a Dash 8-40BW), 684, all the 4300s, all 4400s, all 4500s, all 4600s, 4794, 4814, 4823, 4837, 4857, 4867, 4868, 4874, 4876, 4880, 4896, 4914, 4915, 4916, 4919, 4925, 4926, 4927, 4929 to 4999, and AC4400CWs 5600-5602.

Also, somewhere in the low 4400s, the color under the nose stripes was changed from green to orange. 580, 4423, 4424, 4426, 4432, 4437, 4440, 4442 - 4444, 4448 - 4450, 4453, 4454, 4457, 4458, 4461 - 4580, 4582 through all the 4600s, and AC4400CWs 5600 - 5602 are known to have orange, while 684, most of the 4300s, 4400 - 4409, 4411 - 4413, 4417, 4419 - 4422, 4430, 4433, 4435, 4439, 4445, 4581, 4794, 4814, 4823, 4837, 4857, 4867, 4868, 4847, 4876, 4880, 4896, 4914 - 4916, 4919, 4925 - 4927, 4929 - 4999 are painted green under the nose stripe. As always, refer to photos for confirmation on variations.

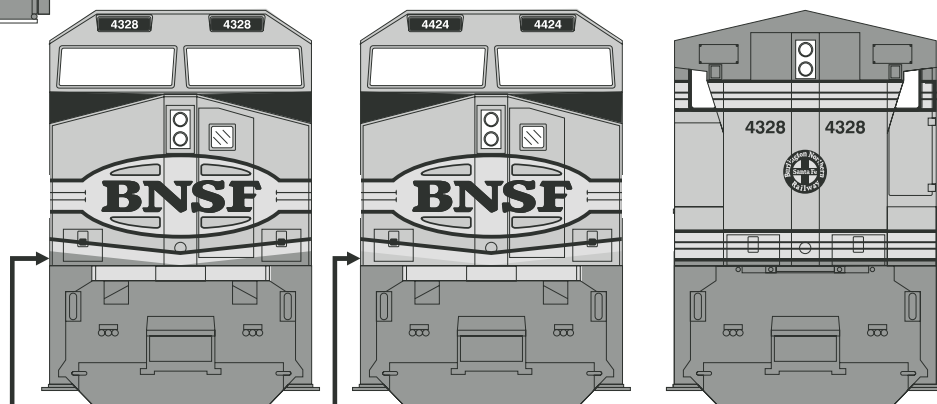

#### **GREEN** (Modelflex 16-151, Scalecoat 61):

Upper portion of long hood, handrails and stanchions, frame, walkways, steps, pilots, snowplow.

#### **ORANGE** (Modelflex 16-152, Scalecoat 46):

Cab, cab roof, nose, middle portion of long hood and rear.

#### **WHITE** (Modelflex 16-02, Scalecoat 11):

Vertical portions of handrails (up to first stanchion), step edges.

#### **SILVER** (Modelflex 16-32, Scalecoat 23):

Fuel tank, truck sideframes, headlight.
