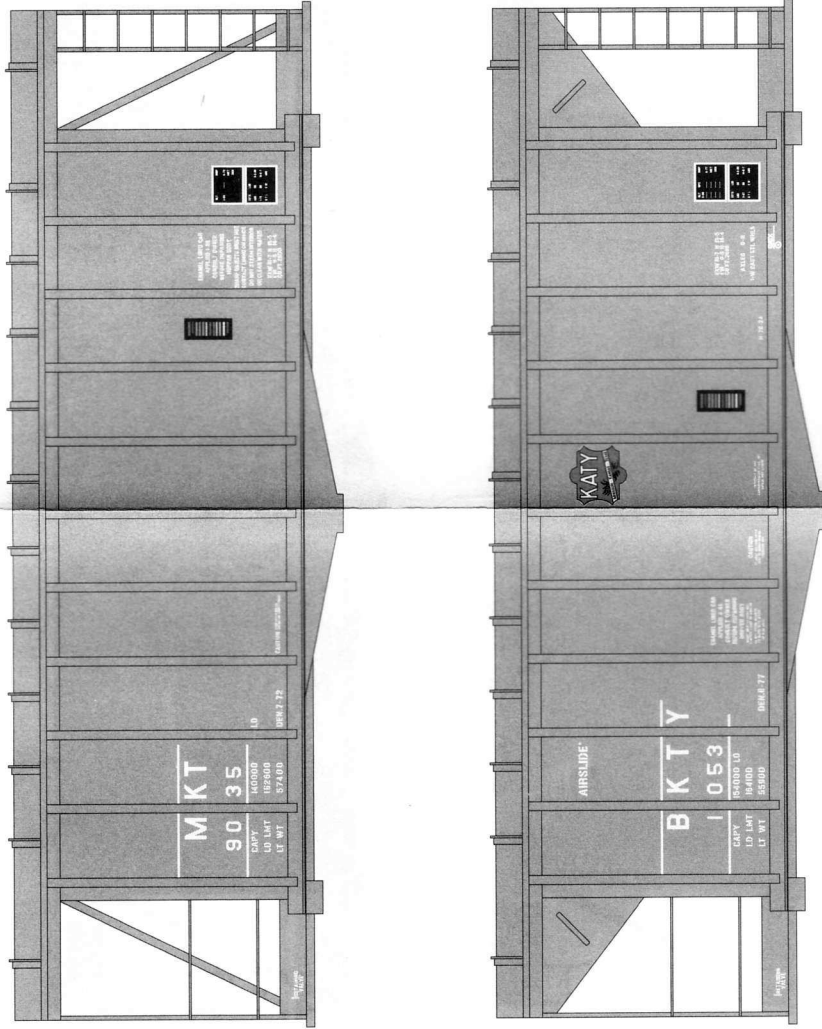


What's out there?

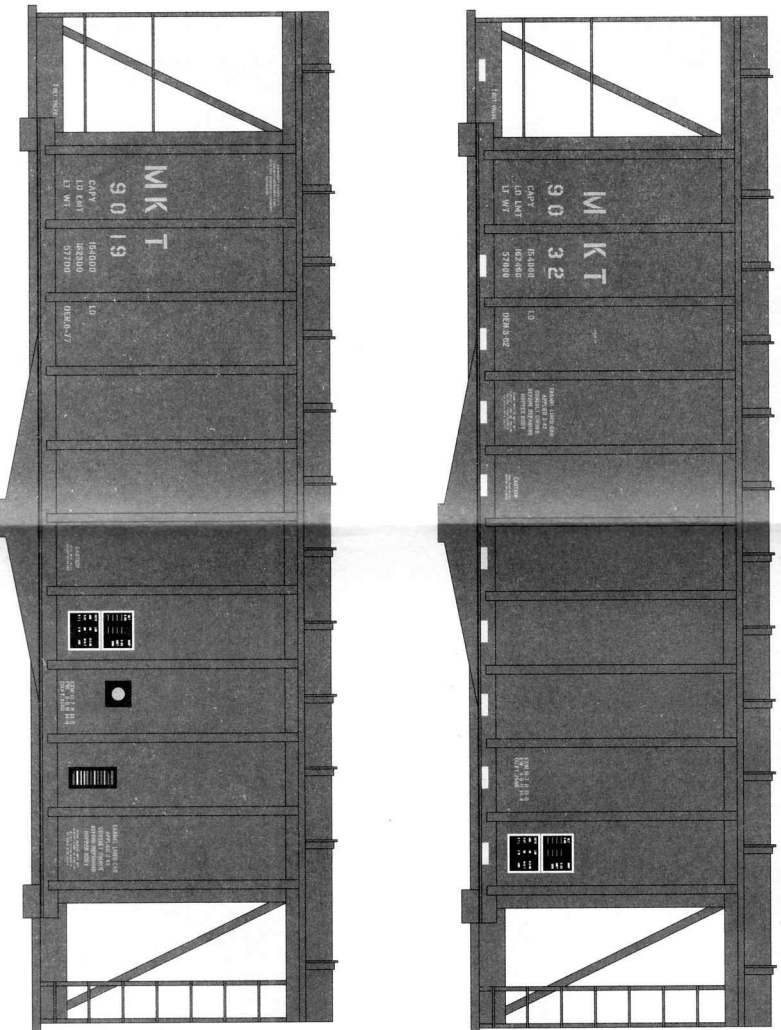

The MKT, or "Katy" operated a small fleet of colorful airslides, with their first cars, MKT 9016-9035, built in January 1959. The next group of cars, MKT 295-299, arrived in 1964. The last group of cars were part of the Commonwealth Plan financed by Southern Pacific, and were numbered BKT 1050-1053. Designed to haul dry, powdery ladings like flour and sugar, these cars were workhorses on the Katy, with many receiving green paint later in their careers.
