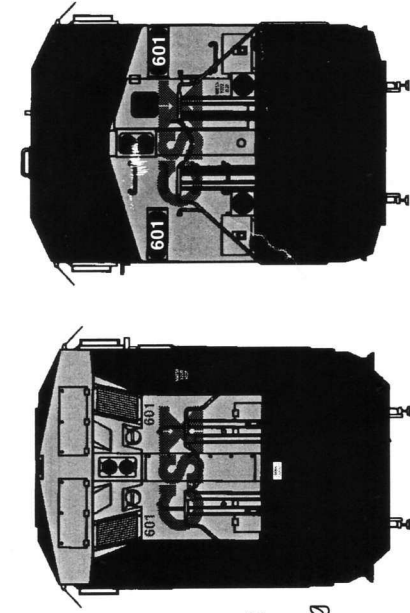
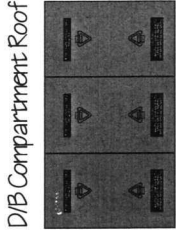


"Named" CSXT AC6000s:

What's in a name? CW60AC, CW44-G, etc....
 Due to engine problems these units began to develop early in their service careers, CSX began derating some of these units to 4,400 hp, re-designating them "CW44-G" in the process. As GE was able to work the bugs out of their prime movers, CSX has begun re-rating these units back to their intended 6,000 hp rating.



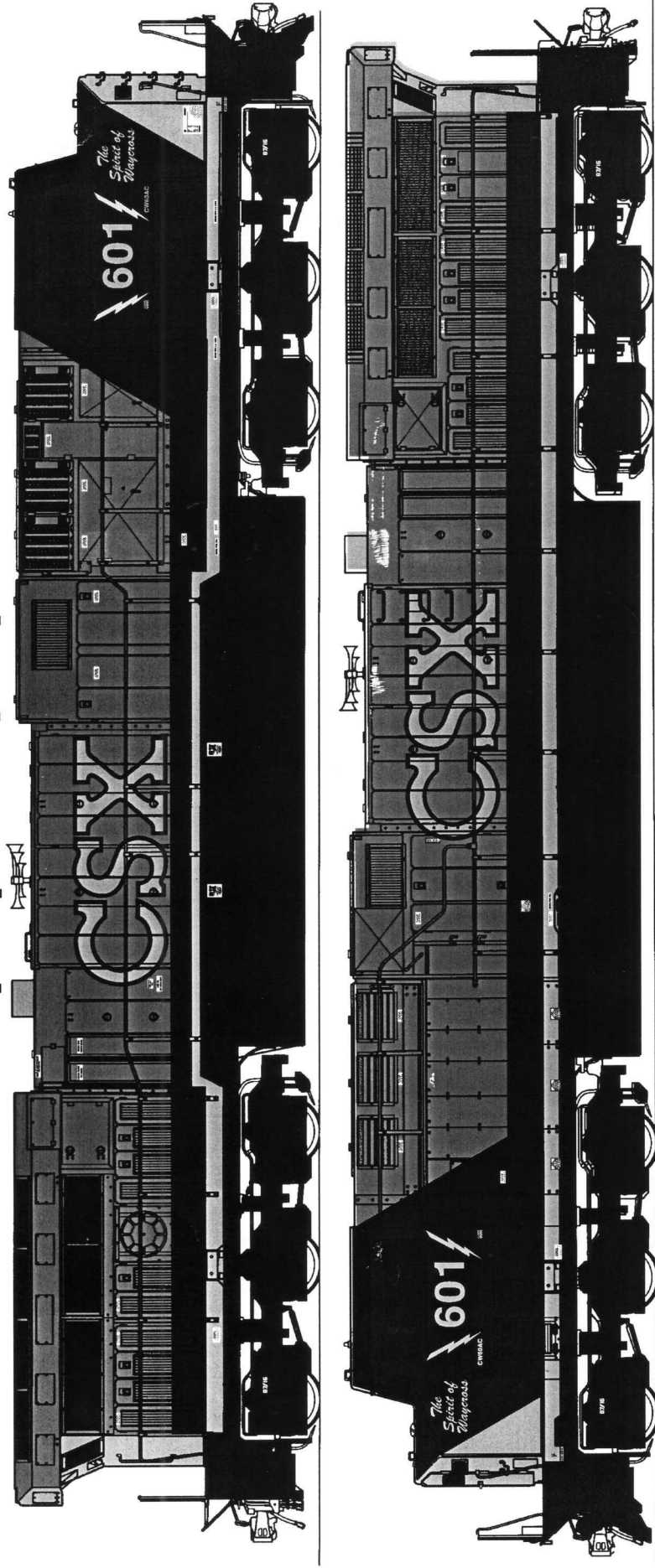
