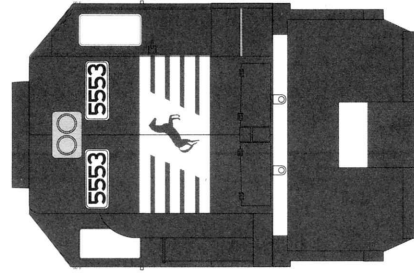
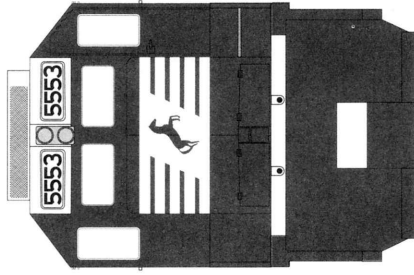
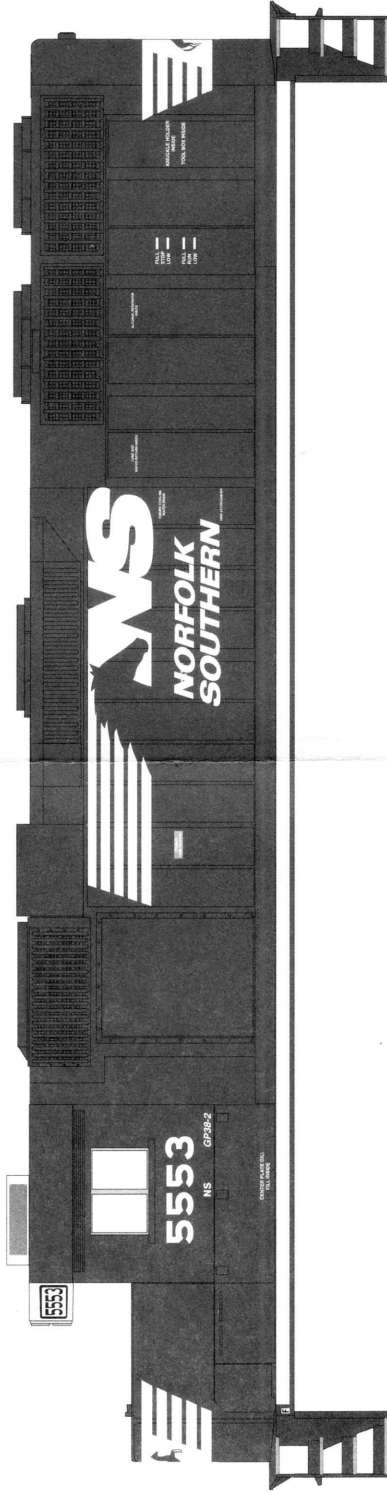


In December 2002 the Norfolk Southern applied a new version of their logo to five diesels: GP38-2s 5284 (ex-Conrail 8089) and 5553 (ex-CR 2770), SD60s 6708 (ex-CR 6853) and 6712 (ex-CR 6858) and SD60 6719 (ex-CR 5580). Beginning in 2003, this new variation of their scheme is to be applied to all diesels as they receive new paint and all new diesels that are delivered.

The majority of Norfolk Southern's diesels featured distinctive high-noses. These can be easily added to HO scale models with Cannon & Company's EMD High-Nose Kit (#191-1101) and Hi-Tech Models GE High-Nose Kit (331-5012). Most of the high-nosed engines are operated with the long-hood as the front. The small "F" that designates the front of a locomotive is placed at the long-hood end of the frame.
