


In 1970, Tropicana orange juice was shipped in bulk via insulated boxcars in one weekly round-trip from Bradenton, Florida, to Kearny, New Jersey. By the following year, the company was operating two 60-car unit trains a week, each carrying around 1,000,000 US gallons (3,800,000 L; 830,000 imp gal) of juice. It is best to refer to photos of prototype Tropicana insulated boxcars and reefers. This decal sheet will do more variations than is possible to show on instruction sheet
