
Both Southern Pacific and Cotton Belt had ACF 1958cuft and PS 2003cuft 2 bay cement hoppers as delivered and as repainted by the SP and SSW. Due to limited space on the decal sheet and vast lettering possibilities, some of the new/shop dates are 1up for the yellow and red versions. To effectively utilize these dates, you will need to acquire another 1390 set. The light gray heralds are for duplicating a weathering effect known as "ghosting" – This happens when the original paint wears off reveailing the base color underneath.
