

Northern Pacific woodchip cars came from FMC-Gunderson in 1969. These cars had some longevity in the original NP paint. Some weren't repainted into BN until the 80s and some can STILL be seen in the original as delivered schemes. NP also rebuilt boxcars into flatcars for wheel service and some in MOW service. These cars could be seen into the mid-1980s. The NP stockcars were in service as late as 1977! Please reference the available articles noted at the bottom of the page for more information.
