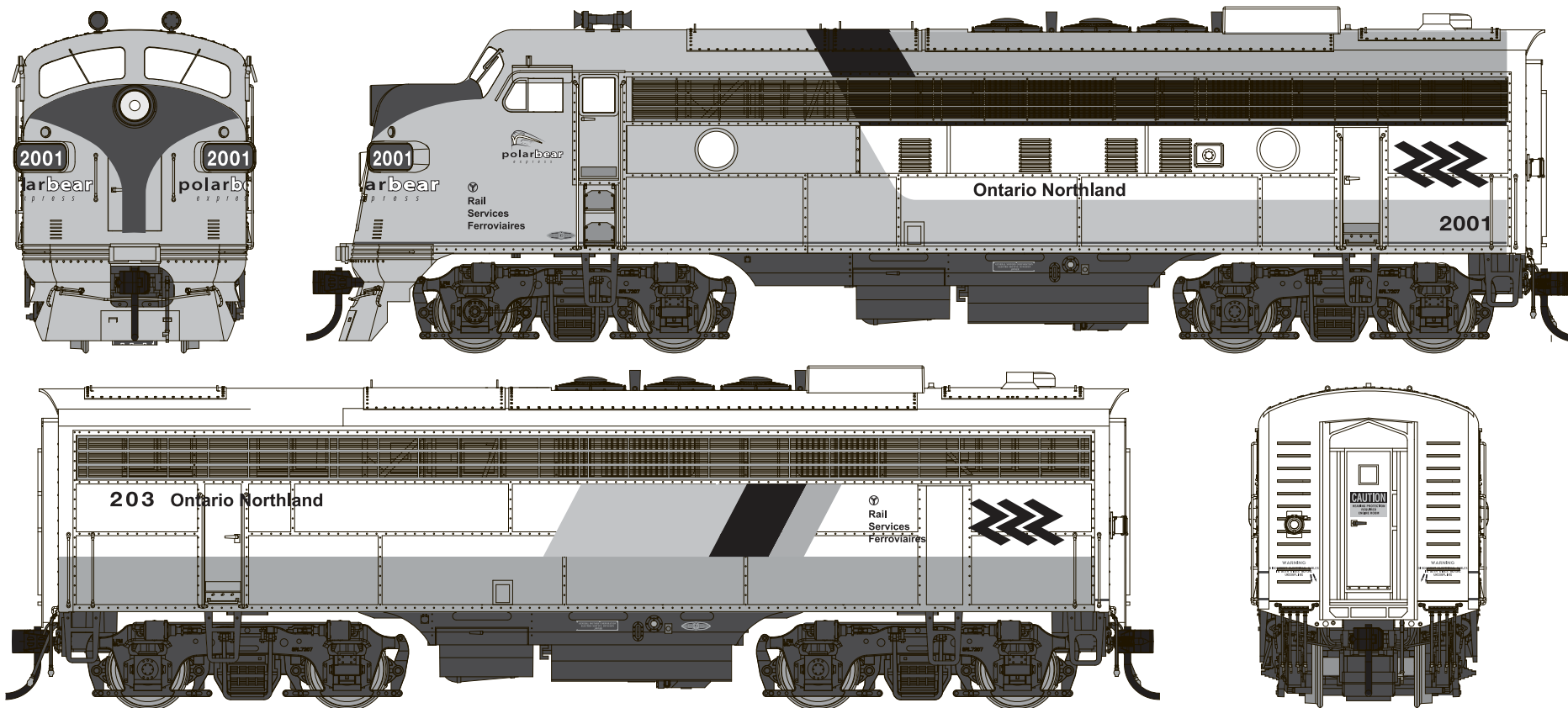


This set will letter passenger cars and locomotives adorned in Ontario Northland's name train The Polar Bear Express. The train operates between Cochrane and Moosonee in Northern Ontario. It originally was a combined freight/passenger train, probably one of the last examples of this in North America. As better funding was awarded, the train became separate freight and passenger. The Polar Bear Express is an essential train to the region, connecting the remote communities together where access is troublesome. The passenger equipment has changed over the years and there have been some unique additions such as a former Milwaukee Road "Super Dome" type dome car named Otter Rapids. F-Unit B's were repurposed and rebuilt into steam generator cars for their passenger service. GP38-2 type diesels are commonly found on this train, occasionally with a large "Polar Bear Express" sign on the side of the handrails (included).
