

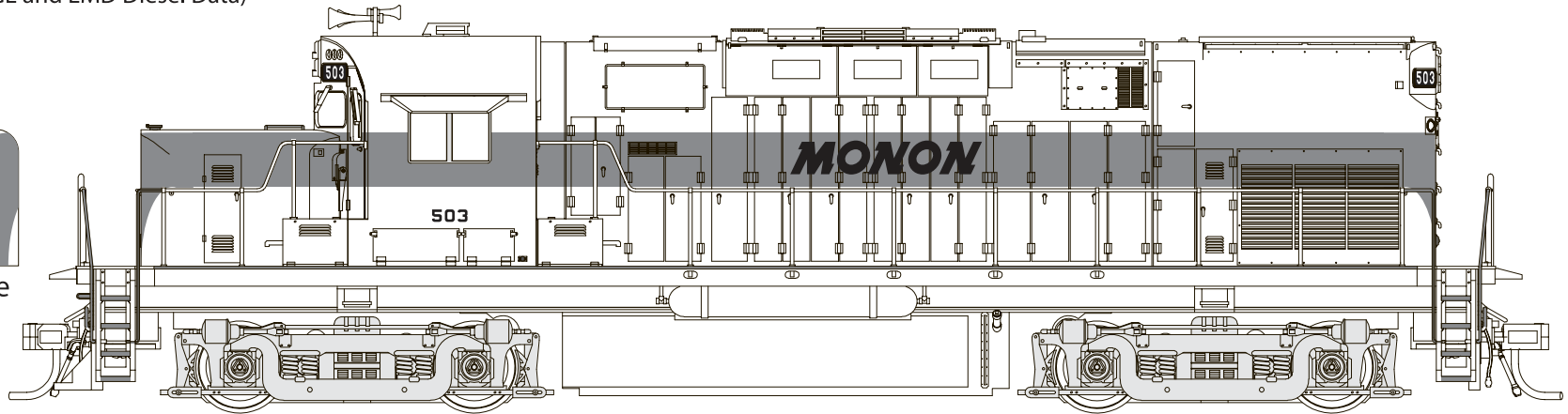
This set will cover a variety of hood Diesels for the Monon Railroad. The black and gold paint scheme used by both DePauw University and Purdue University adorned the railroad's diesel freight locomotives and later replaced the red and white on passenger equipment as well. Monon became one of the first Class I railroads to fully convert to diesel motive power in June 1949. More info on the Monon at monon.org

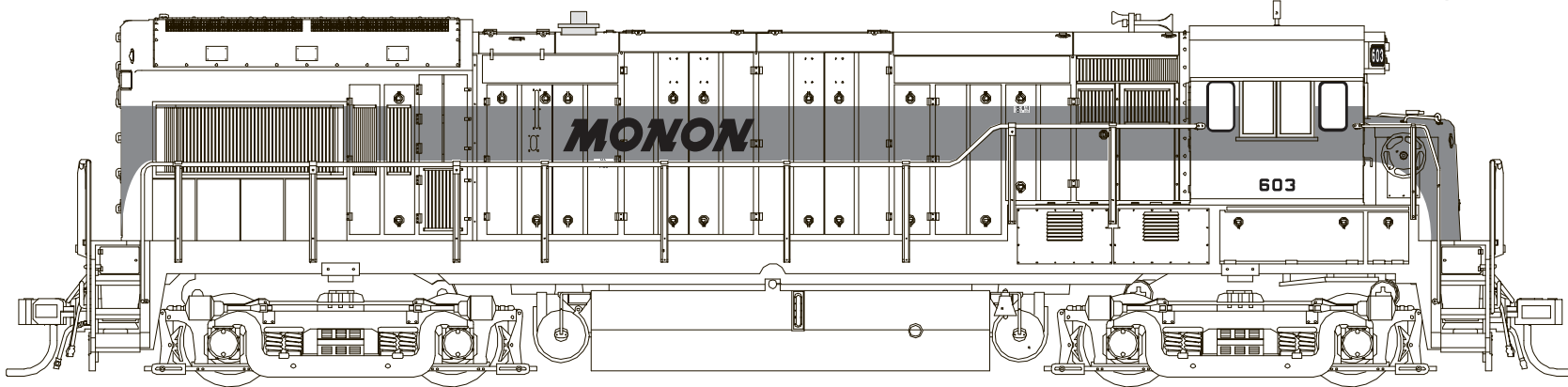
