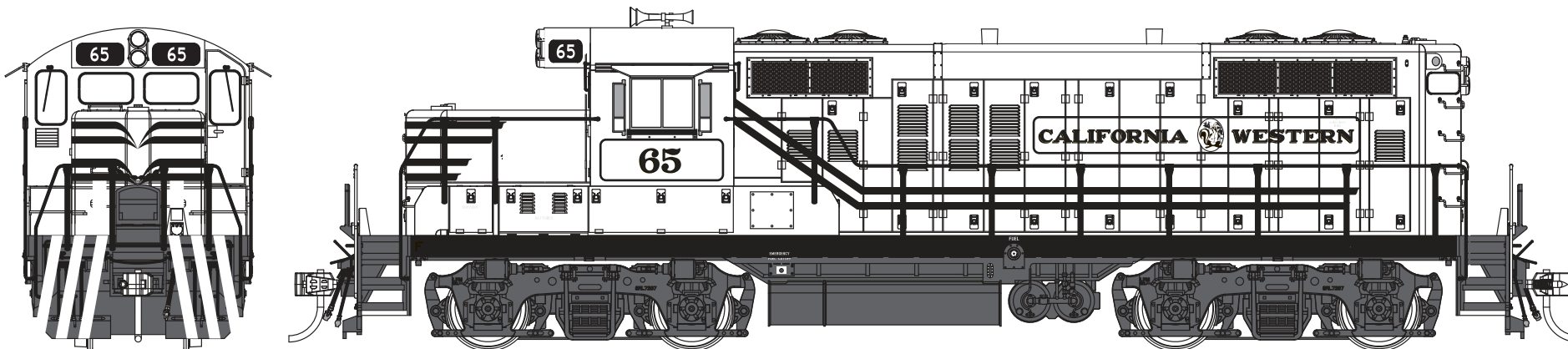


The California Western Railroad purchased 4 GP9 type locomotives as successors to their aging Baldwin and Alco fleet. These locomotives were purchased to handle both freight and passenger excursion traffic. Today the passenger excursion trains are the railroad's sole source of revenue. Freight traffic is likely to restart as the NWP is being re-opened. Occasionally, the CWR stores equipment on NWP trackage. The Arcata & Mad River Railroad had 4 GE 44 tonner type locomotives. Locomotive 101 is operational and utilized by the Timber Heritage Association.

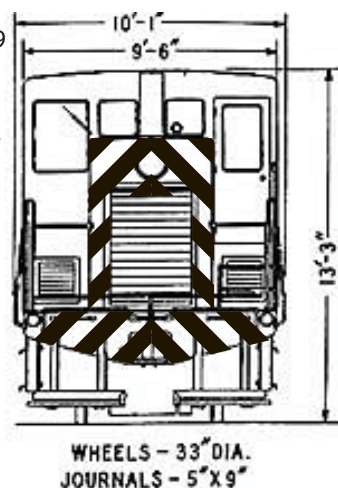

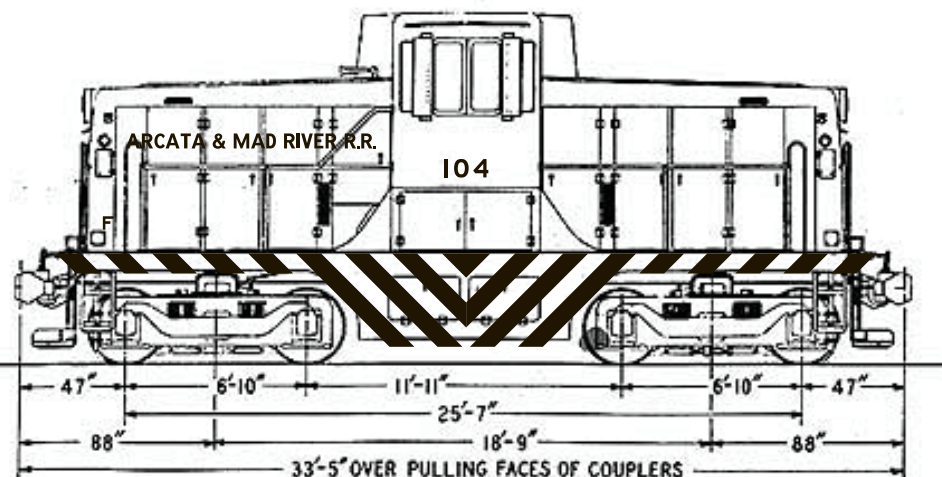
