



Paint Notes- Early units overall black. 2" striping along side sill. The initials L&A are indicative of the Lousiana & Arkansas Rwy. and are applied as shown on NW2 1126 and HH1000 No.1122. Note that most photos show only Kansas City Southern but 1126 includes words lines. The photos shown are representative and a guide of lettering but do not indicate all variations. Handrails are yellow at ends adjacent to platform steps. Some interium units painted red and carried yellow Cab logo and road name. Underbody, trucks, fuel tanks painted black.
