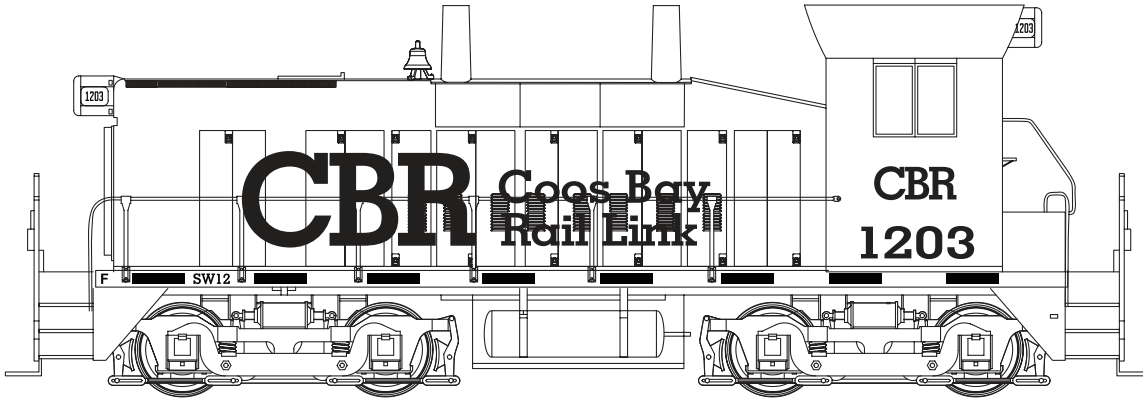
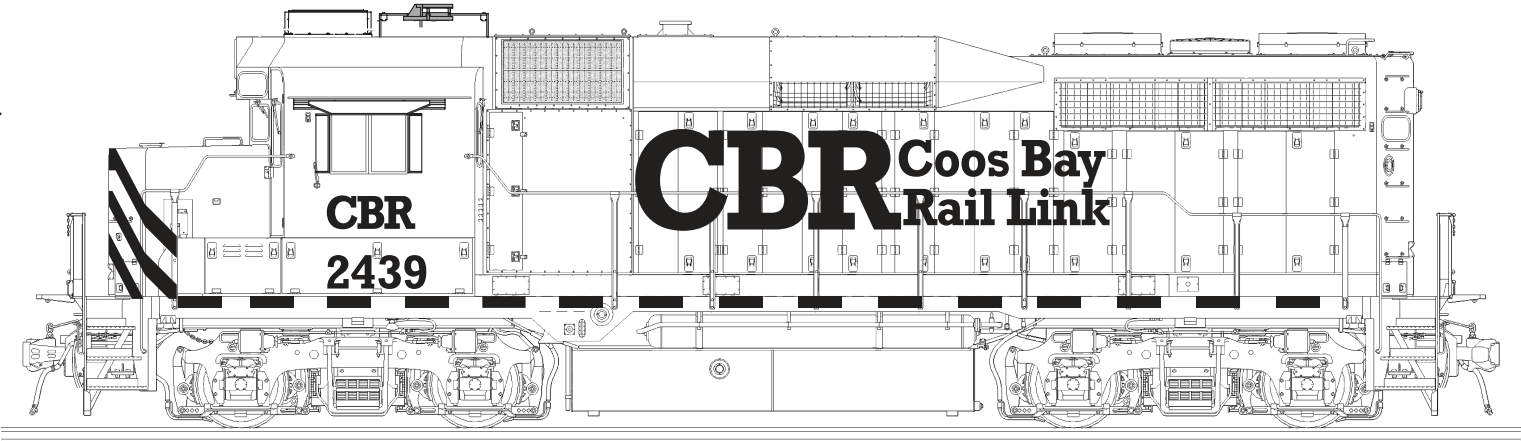
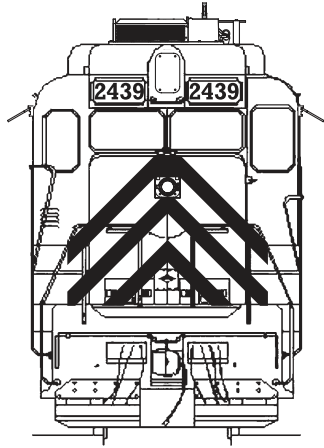


The Coos Bay Rail Link is a 134-mile (216 km) railroad line from the Willamette Valley to the Port of Coos Bay on the Oregon Coast and Coquille, Oregon, in the United States. On April 29, 2013, CBR restored full service to the entire 134-mile Coos Bay rail line (formerly SP). CBR marked the day by hauling the first rail cars of plywood in 5.5 years from the Roseburg Forest Products mill in Coquille, Ore., north toward connections in Eugene, Ore., with the North American freight rail system.
