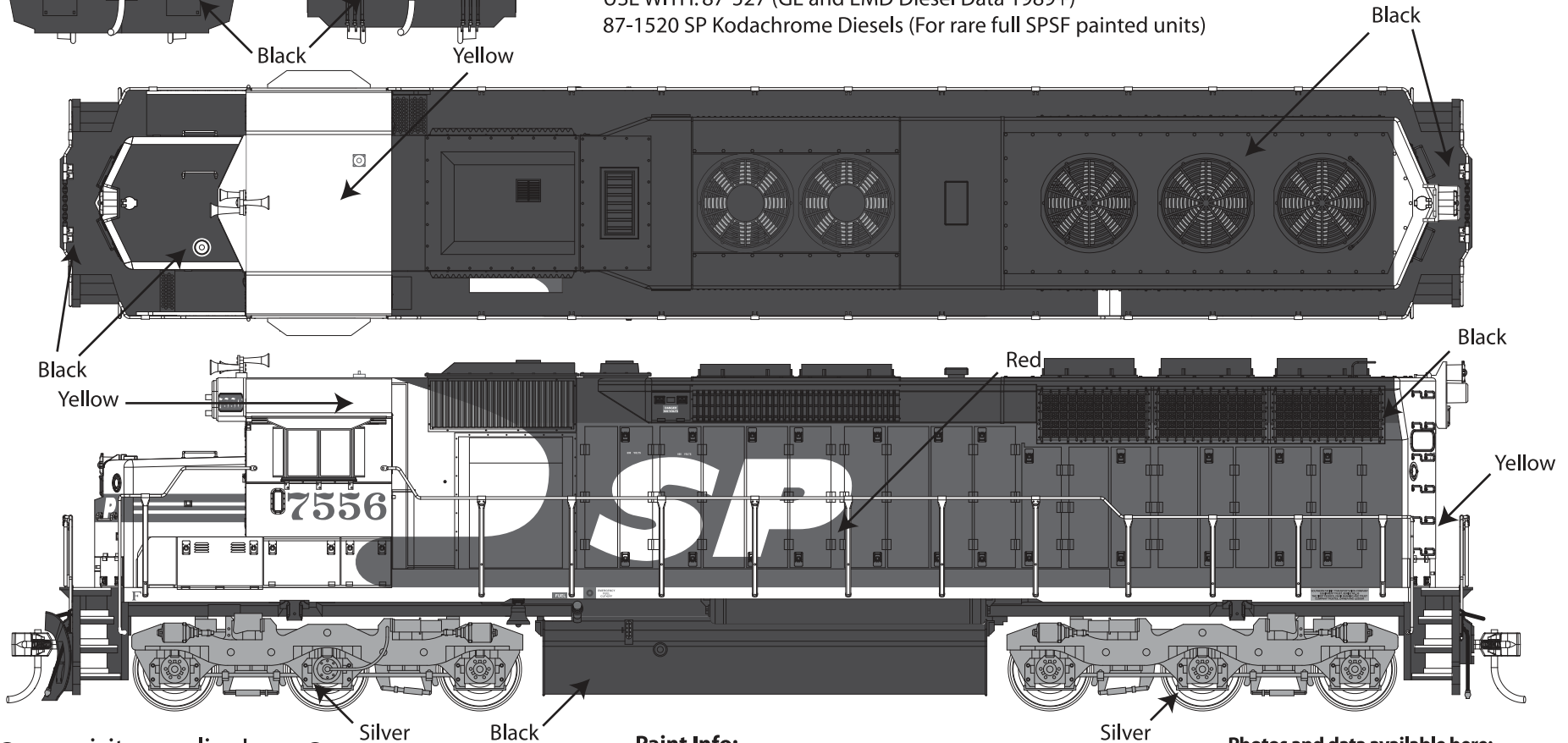


"Shouldn't Paint So Fast" is the acronym for the failed Southern Pacific Santa Fe (SPSF) merger in the mid 1980s. Although the merger didn't occur, these distinctive locomotives brought a lot of color to the time and lasted through to 1991. In this set you will find several nose heralds of different lengths. On the sheet a description indicates their intended usage. Some instances (like the EMD 81" to 123") nose will require some trimming in order to fit the shorter size noses. Be sure to reference prototype photos when decaling. This scheme evolved quite a bit and different nose heralds were utilized. Photos will help maintain accuracy of your models.
