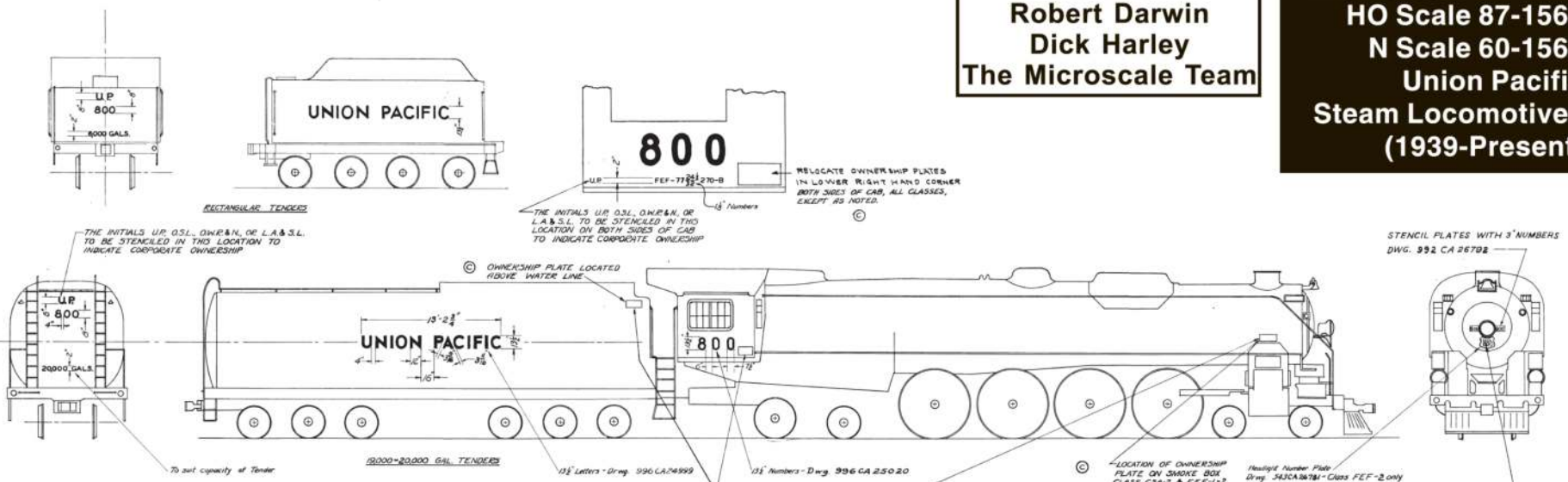

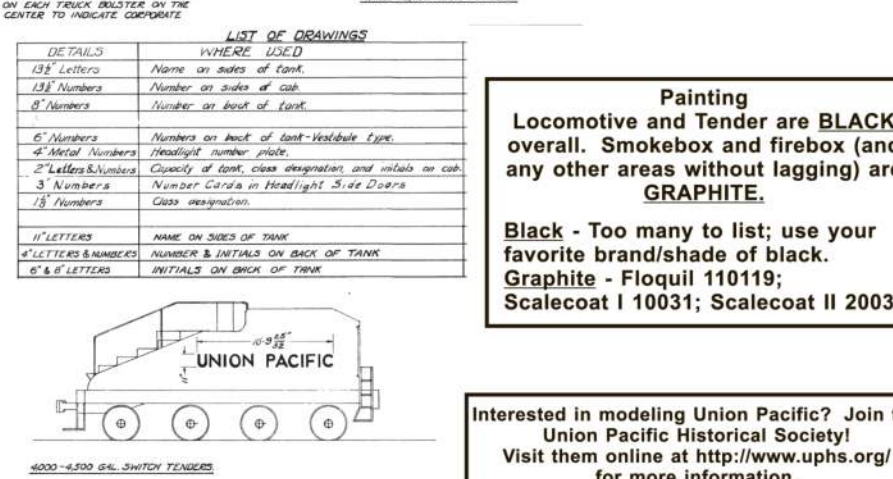
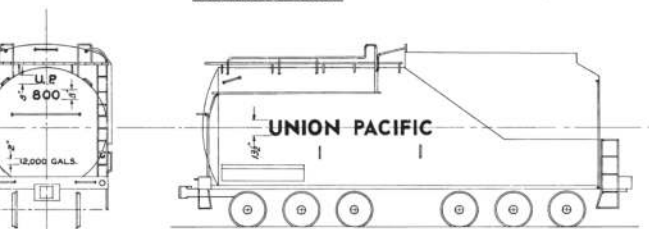

Note that the "UNION PACIFIC" tender lettering changed from a circle "O" to the oval "O" in June, 1956. Engines painted after that date would use the oval lettering.

On all tender drawings shown below with equipment boxes forward of the rear sill, note that the usual location of the "FIRE HOSE ONLY" lettering is on the side of the box on the opposite (left) side of the tender, but this lettering was not applied to all tenders.

The Coal or Oil and Water Capacity must be stenciled in 2" letters and figures in accordance with exactly shown in locomotive and tender specifications.

| DETAILS | WHERE USED |
|----------------------|---|
| 13 1/2" Letters | Name on sides of tank. |
| 13 1/2" Numbers | Number on sides of cab. |
| 8" Numbers | Number on front of tank. |
| 6" Numbers | Numbers on back of tank - Vestibule type. |
| 4" Metal Numbers | Headlight number plate. |
| 2" Letters & Numbers | Capacity of tank, class designation, and initials on cab. |
| 3" Numbers | Number Cards in Headlight Side Doors |
| 1 1/2" Numbers | Class designation. |
| 11" LETTERS | NAME ON SIDES OF TANK |
| 4" LETTERS & NUMBERS | NUMBER & INITIALS ON BACK OF TANK |
| 6" & 8" LETTERS | INITIALS ON BRICK OF TANK |

**Painting
Locomotive and Tender are BLACK overall. Smokebox and firebox (and any other areas without lagging) are GRAPHITE.**

**Black - Too many to list; use your favorite brand/shade of black.
Graphite - Floquil 110119;
Scalecoat I 10031; Scalecoat II 20031**
