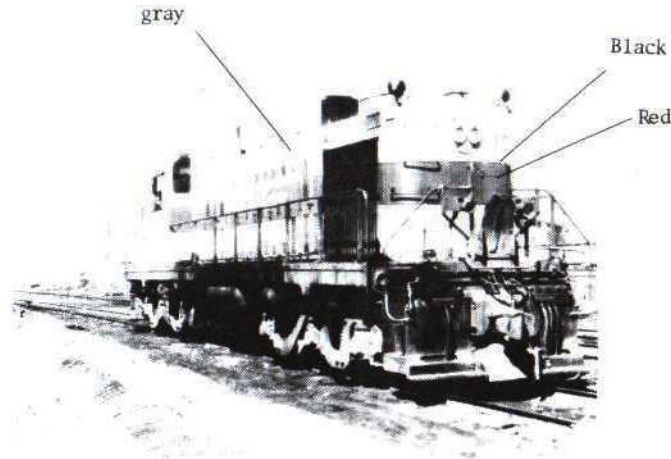

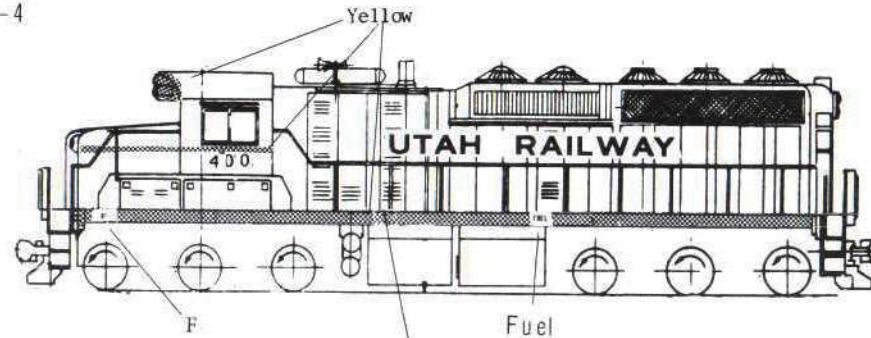
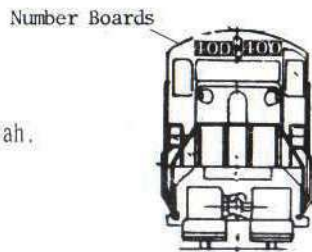
UTAH RAILWAY COLOR NOTES

Early alco RSD painted gray with Red Band. Cab Numbers and road name Yellow. End hood nos. are Red. Pilots, Fuel tanks, trucks, side sills are Black.

Later acquisition DL 600B units retain their original Santa Fe Blue and Yellow with no. 403 having the Blue "Warbonnet" scheme. Cab nos. are Yellow road name Yellow, and end lettering is Red. The one exception is Red road nos. for #403.

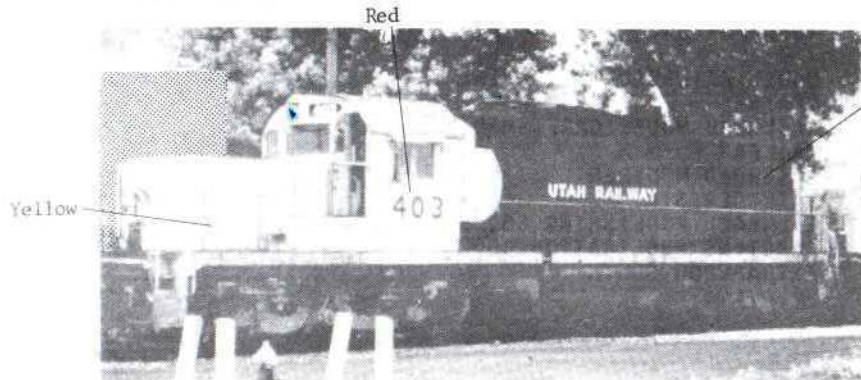
RSD-12 No. 60 painted overall S.F. Blue with Yellow road name & numbers.

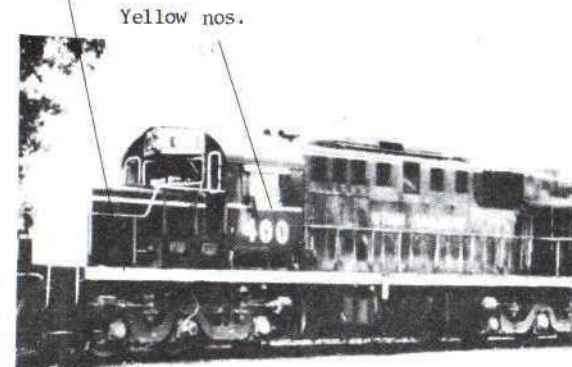
