In 1983 Santa Fe constructed two SD45B units (5501 and 5502) from regular SD45s in an effort to improve reliability in these old work horses. The SD45Bs had short hood salvaged from GP9 and GP20 shells, In 1987 and 1988 Santa Fe rebuilt eight SD45-2s into SD45-2B units (5510 - 5517). These utilized new high hoods manufactured by the Santa Fe rather than from scrapped engines. The end logos have varied over the years, and this chart shows which logos were used on which engines (note that some have worn more than one style over time).



BLUE (Accupaint AP-63, Floquil 110177, Modelflex 16-34, Scalecoat 24, Scalecoat II 2024):
Long hood, walkways, pilots, anti-glare panel on top of
nose (or use decal set 87-440 in HO or 60-440 in N).

YELLOW (Accupaint AP-64, Floquil 110178, Modelflex 16-33, Scalecoat 15, Scalecoat II 2015): Cab, frame, nose, handrails, handrail stanchions, step edges.

BLACK (Accupaint AP-2, Floquil 110354, Modelflex 16-01, Scalecoat 10, Scalecoat II 2010): Fuel tank.

SILVER (Accupaint AP-40, Floquil 110100, Modelflex 16-32, Scalecoat 23, Scalecoat II 2023):
Truck sideframes.



Several B23-7 diesels were upgraded to 3000 horsepower in 1988. Some of these carried "3000 H.P." stencils under the cab numbers. These engines were numbered 7201 through 7216. In mid-1989 these engines were derated back to their original 2250 hp and numbered back to their original numbers: 6366 - 6370, 6372 - 6379, 6389, 6393 and 6395. Some were renumbered before being derated (for example, 6376 carried the stencil after renumbering).



For Black numbers on White number boards, use set 87-904 (HO) or 60-904 (N) for the backgrounds, and MC-4129 (HO) or 60-4129 (N) for the numbers.
