CONTINUED TO USE THE BLACK BACKGROUND UP TO THE 1960s.

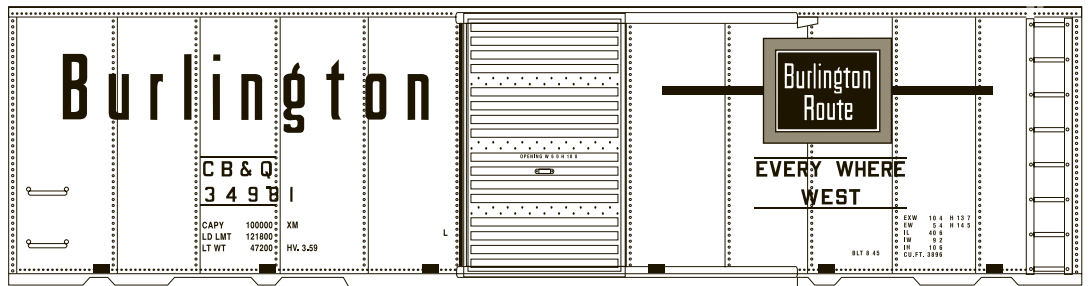
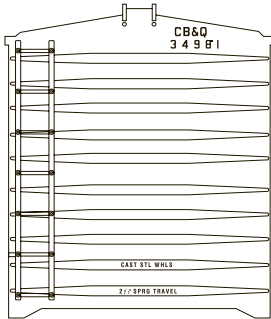

XM-32 40' STEEL BOX CARS



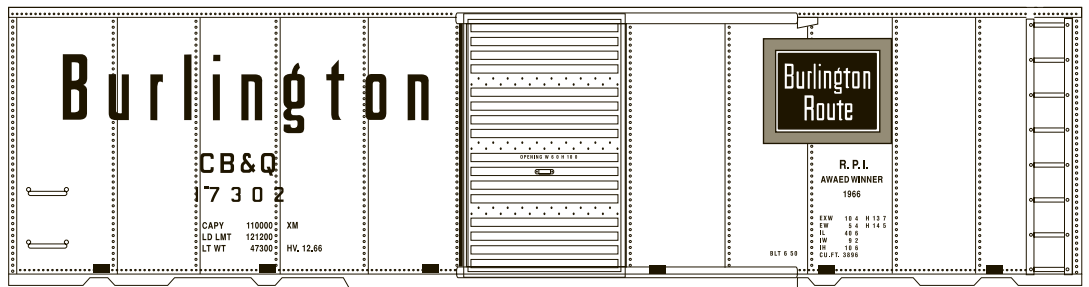
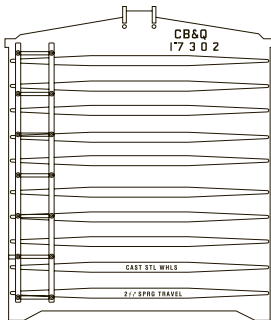
1958-MID 1968
