
AMTRAK DIESEL LOCOMOTIVES Phase III paint scheme




The lowered separation line on upper Black color is a common variation.

COLORS:

Black-Top and underframe Platinum Mist-Body When placing striping, Red stripe is the upper stripe.

Rear numbers are not always used.



These locomotives have been seen with both White and Scotchlite® trim around the side numbers and the Amtrak on the nose. We have furnished both versions. Note, one locomotive has been seen with no trim color around these items.

Black and White number board numerals have been included for additional locomotives including SDP40Fs, (numbers 511 thru 649). Enough side numbers have been included to allow modelers to create many number combinations

F40PH shown, markings and stripes are placed in the same relative positions for most other Amtrak cab locomotives.
