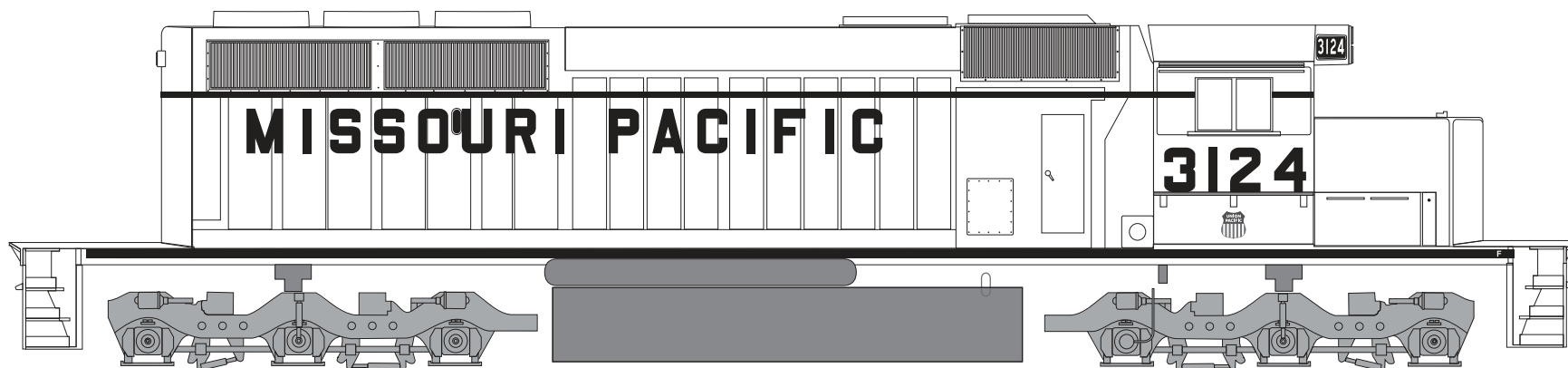


When Union Pacific merged with both Western Pacific and Missouri Pacific, UP had to operate MoPac as a separate railroad. UP adapted their paint scheme but with MoPac's lettering. Western Pacific before being acquired by UP leased a few SD40-2s. UP lettered "LEASED TO WESTERN PACIFIC" in 3 inch letters under the cab window. Locomotives that were leased include 3352, 3360, 3419, 3421, 3424, 3475, 3478, 3504, 3519, 3528, 3536, 3542, 3546, 3565.

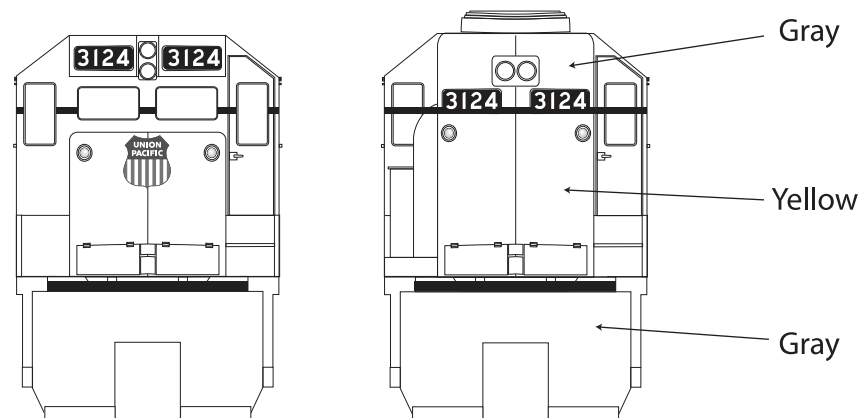
