STEP EDGES AND HANDRAIL ENDS ARE WHITE

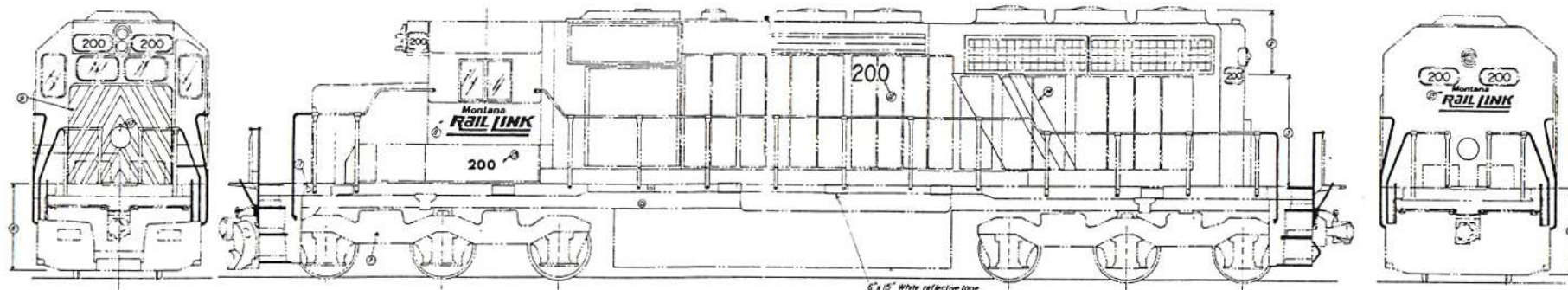
