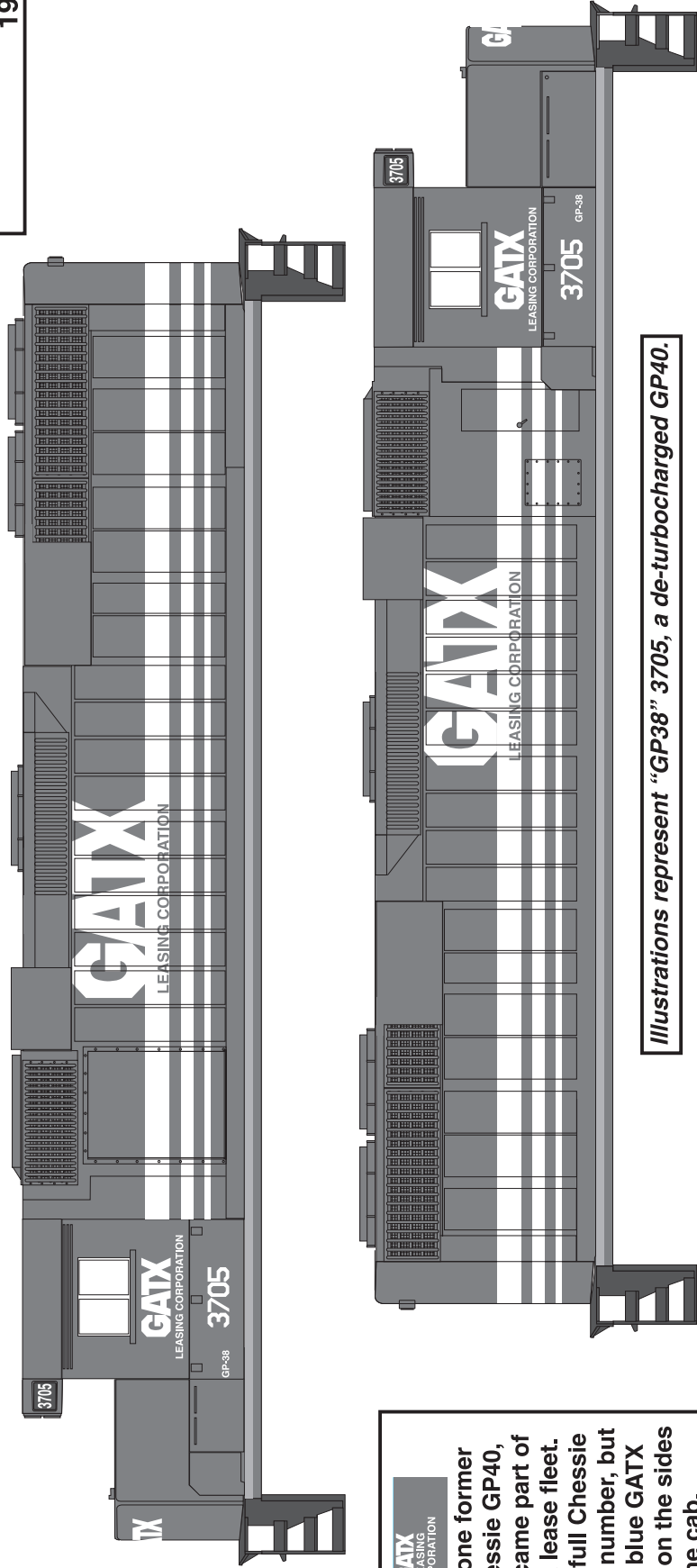

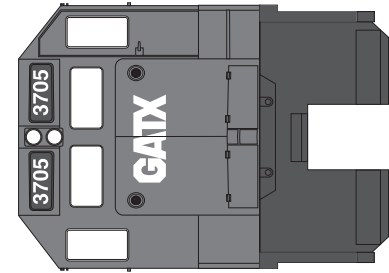

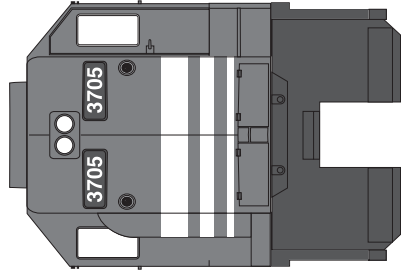
At least one former B&O/Chessie GP40, 3735, became part of the GATX lease fleet. It kept its full Chessie paint and number, but received blue GATX "patches" on the sides of the cab.

Illustrations represent "GP38" 3705, a de-turbocharged GP40.

Hoods, ends, cab, and *sidesills are blue (close to Conrail blue).
 Stepwells, pilots, walkways, trucks, fuel tank, and underframe are black.



In addition to their freight car fleet, GATX Corporation is also known for their fleet of lease locomotives. These blue units are a common sight on power-hungry railroads, both large and small, all across North America. Their diverse fleet of road and switch engines includes units from Milwaukee Road, UP (ex-MP), Reserve Mining, and Conrail (ex-Reading).
 Because of this diversity, and the number of painting and lettering variations, it is impossible to cover all of the subtle differences of their fleet in this small space. It is HIGHLY recommended that you refer to prototype photographs of the unit you wish to model.



Blue (close to Conrail blue): Accu+Paint 7, Floquil 110058, Modelflex 1629, Scalecoat I 75, Scalecoat II 2075
 Black: Accu+Paint 2, Floquil 110010, Modelflex 1601, Scalecoat I 10, Scalecoat II 2010
 *On some units, the entire sidesill was painted yellow; Reefer Yellow would be close. Modelflex 1610, Floquil 110031, Scalecoat I 15, Scalecoat II 2015
