

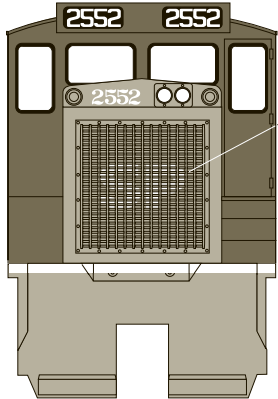

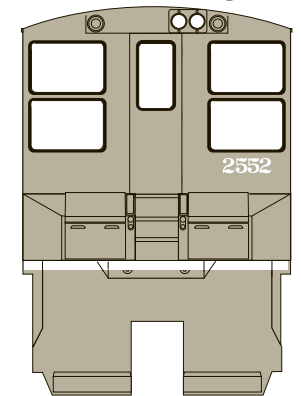

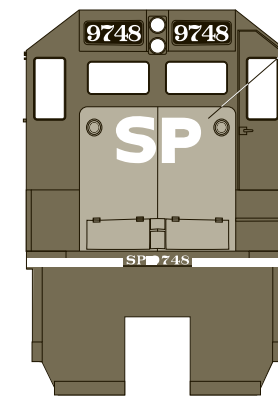


Note the "SP" initials applied to the shutters behind the grille

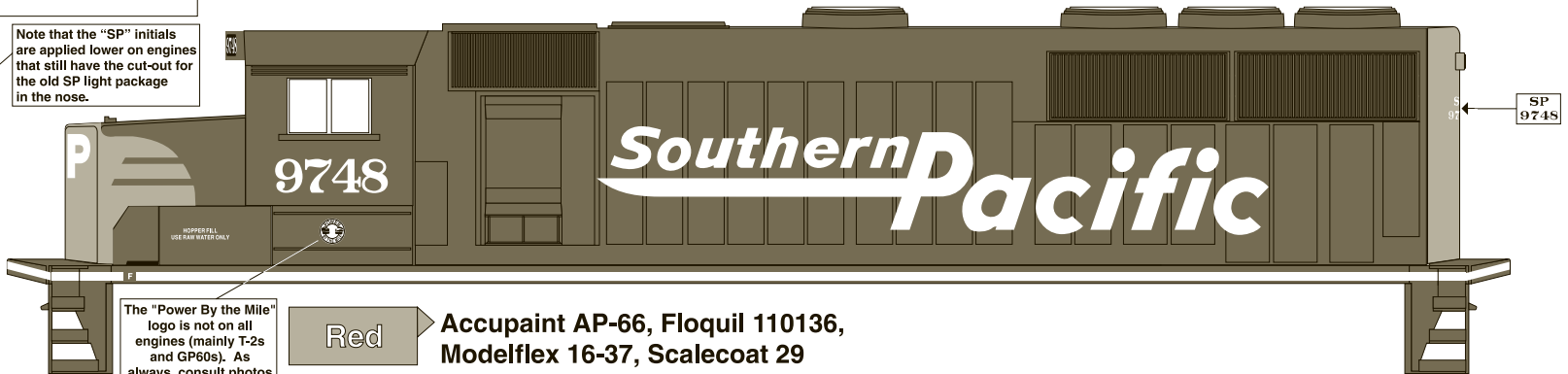


**SP** The slanted nose-logo was applied to a few units, notably 7264, 7644, 7677 and 7804

- Red** → Frame (switcher only), cab end (switcher only), pilots (switcher only), hood ends, nose wings
- Grey** → Entire engine: Hood, cab, fuel tank, air tank, truck sideframes, handrails (vertical portion from step well to first stanchion are White), snowplow, pilots



Note that the "SP" initials are applied lower on engines that still have the cut-out for the old SP light package in the nose.

- Red** → Accupaint AP-66, Floquil 110136, Modelflex 16-37, Scalecoat 29
- Grey** → Accupaint AP-65, Floquil 110132, Modelflex 16-40, Scalecoat 28

The "Power By the Mile" logo is not on all engines (mainly T-2s and GP60s). As always, consult photos of the prototype to insure accuracy.
