

SOLID BLUE OR BLACK SCHEMES & EXPERIMENTAL SCHEMES


BLUE OR BLACK SCHEMES

ON HOOD UNITS THE ENDS OF THE HAND RAILS BY STEPS TO
FIRST STANTION ARE YELLOW.
PASSENGER E & F-UNITS THE CAR BODY IS PAINTED A DARK BLUE.
ALL LETTERING IS THE SAME.





EXPERIMENTAL SCHEMES

LOCOMOTIVE # 366 WAS PAINTED IN A EXPERIMENTAL ALL BLACK SCHEME.
ALL LETTERING IS THE SAME AS THE STANDARD ALL BLACK SCHEME. A THREE
DIAMOND LOGO WAS PLACED ON THE NOSE. THIS LOGO HAD A YELLOW BORDER
AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF THE DIAMONDS.



LOCOMOTIVES # 369 & 913 WERE PAINTED IN A ALL LIGHT GRAY SCHEME. THE
GRAY COLOR APPEARS TO BE THE SAME GRAY COLOR USED ON LATER L&N
SCHEMES. PILOTS, TRUCKS, FUEL TANK AND UNDERBODY WERE BLACK. THE
LETTERING ON BOTH LOCOMOTIVES WAS RED WITH A BLACK OUTLINE. UNIT
369 HAD A 3 DIAMOND LOGO ON THE NOSE. THIS LOGO HAD A BLACK BORDER
AROUND THE DIAMONDS. UNIT # 913 HAD THE ROUND DIXIE LINE LOGO ON THE NOSE.
