



Phoenix missile pallets are painted the underside color of the F-14's in any particular squadron. If the Squadron has a mix of Lt. Gull Gray and White aircraft, along

with overall Lt. Gull Gray aircraft, you may see Gray missile pallets on Gray/White aircraft and White missile pallets on overall Gray aircraft. The Gray carried on F-14's is Lt. Gull Gray FS 36440. This color has a slight gloss sheen to it. Undersurface White is FS 27875. Leading edges on all flying surfaces are Natural Metal.

## GENERAL PAINTING NOTES:

Cockpit Interior: Dark Green FS 36231

This includes floor, bulkheads, side panels, instrument panels, seat frame and canopy inside bracing.

## Ejection Seat:

Dark Gull Gray FS 36231: Seat frame.
Dark Green FS 34079: Parachute rack and seat cushion.
Black: FS 17038: Headrest and seat rails.

Yellow FS 33538: Face curtain handles




Wheel Wells, Door Insides and Wheel Struts:


Gloss White FS 27875: Interior of wheel wells, inside of gear doors, wheel struts, wheel hubs, interior of engine intakes access panels.

Gloss Insignia Red FS 31136: Edges on all landing gear doors. Natural Metal: Oleo struts, lips on intakes and panel in front.









NOTE- Stenciling is always placed on missiles to be readable when missile is mounted on aircraft
