

To model US Army equipment (tanks, jeeps, etc), use Microscale MC-4279 in HO, 60-4279 in N and 13-8 in O Scale.

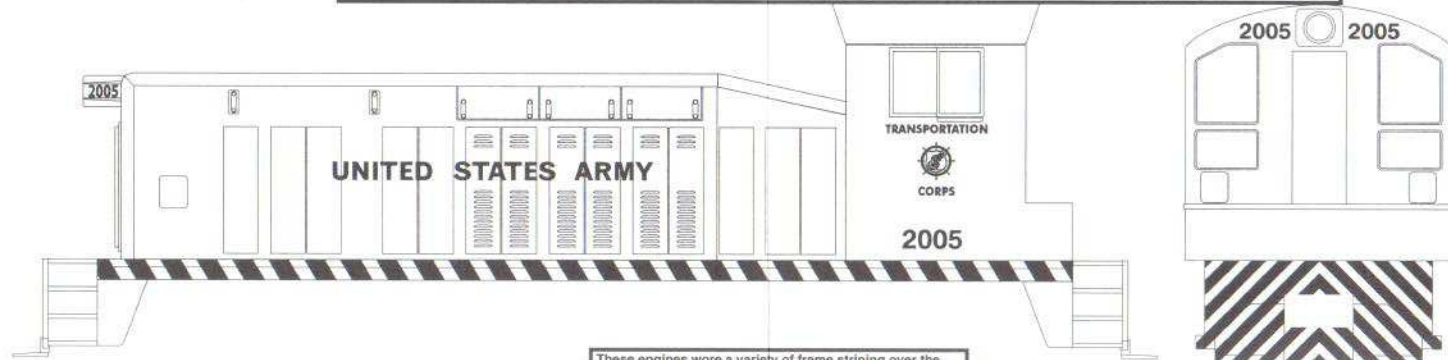
TRANSPORTATION CORPS Most of the Army's diesels were delivered with the Transportation Corps' logo, but by the 1960s this logo had been removed from most engines.

The United States Army Transportation Corps operated a variety of diesel locomotives, including:

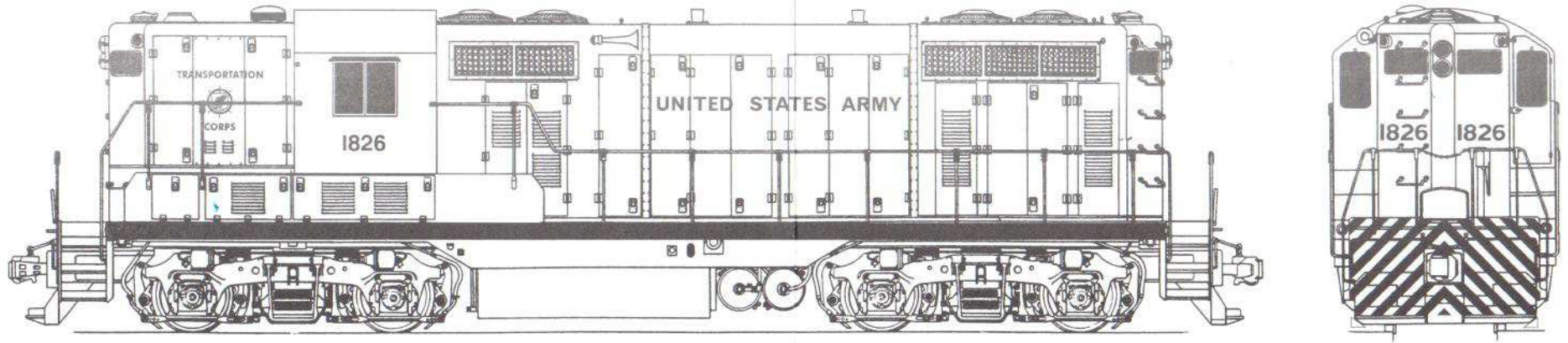
