

This set covers post 1970's era delivered and repainted Reefers from R-70-15 to the R-70-25s

Examine prototype photographs as some cars with the White 14" reporting marks have heavier (bolder) number font than others. The differences in font weight are noted on the decal sheet.

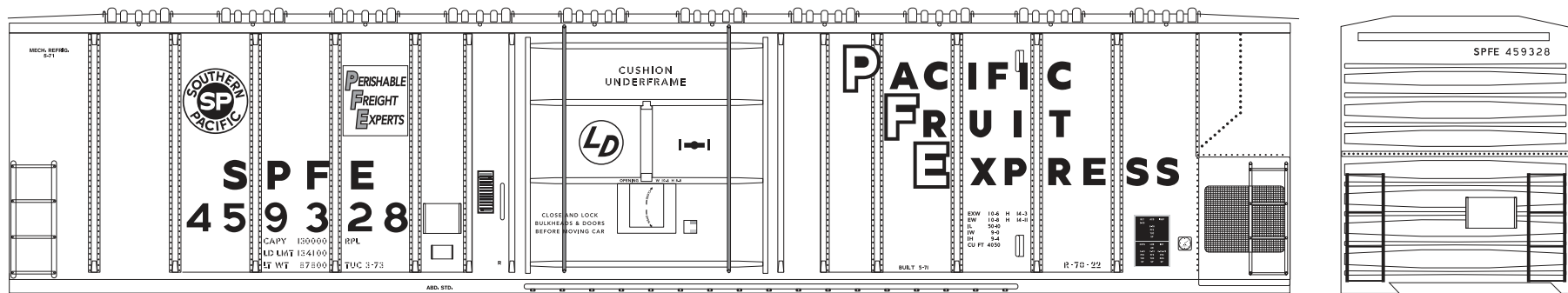
The SP Medallion is always closest to the B-end (brake wheel end) of the car while the UP Medallion is always located closest to the Refrigeration Unit.

This set also includes several variations to the UP medallion the inverted UP shield was used briefly on a few as delivered cars. Consult photographs!

Several different PERISHABLE FREIGHT EXPERT Medallions are available to match the various prototype versions. There were used to cover the UP shield after PFE split into SPFE and UPFE in March of 1978

This set replaces 87-250, 87-409, and MC-4379
