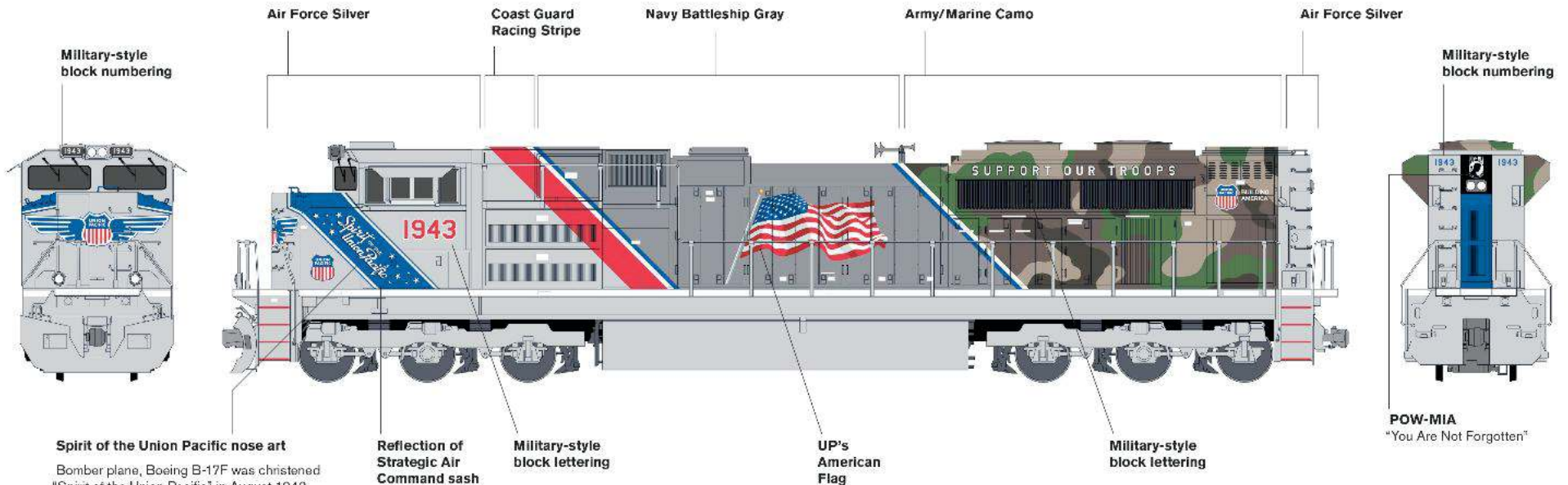

LOCOMOTIVE NO. 1943 THE SPIRIT



Spirit of the Union Pacific nose art
Bomber plane, Boeing B-17F was christened "Spirit of the Union Pacific" in August 1943. Funded by war bond contributions from Union Pacific employees, it was the first heavy bomber to be named after a railroad. The "Spirit of the Union Pacific" flew as part of the 571st Bomber Squadron and was shot down on its fifth mission during a raid on enemy installations at Munster, Germany.

Union Pacific veterans collaborated on The Spirit's design, honoring the U.S. Armed Forces with symbolic graphics and color palette.
